**THE MEETING WAS OPENED BY SUPERVISOR BERENS, FOLLOWED BY PRAYER AND THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.**

STILLE-MULLIGAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MAY 2008 MINUTES AS PRESENTED. CLARK SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

GAIL RINGLEBERG FROM NOCOA GAVE A REPORT AND PASSED OUT BROCHURES SHOWING SERVICES OFFERED AT THE SENIOR CENTER.

WILLIAM MASCHEWSKE ANSWERED QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE MASTER USE PLAN. MAPS WERE REVIEWED. STILLE-MULLIGAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE RESOLUTION 2008-06-14 FOR THE MASTER USE PLAN AS PRESENTED TO THE PUBLIC AT A PUBLIC HEARING ON 02/26/2008. KUYERS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: KUYERS, STILLE-MULLIGAN, CLARK, FRYE, AND BERENS. NAYS: NONE. THE MASTER USE PLAN WAS APPROVED.

OTTAWA COUNTY TREASURER BRAD SLAGH GAVE AN UPDATE ON THE COUNTY TREASURER'S OFFICE AND ANSWERED QUESTIONS.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE RESOLUTION 2008-06-14 SUPPORTING THE CONTINUATION OF THE EXISTING OTTAWA COUNTY 911 MILLAGE. THE REQUEST IS TO BE ON THE AUGUST 5,2008 BALLOT. CLARK SECONDED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: STILLE-MULLIGAN, BERENS, CLARK, FRYE AND KUYERS. NAYS: NONE. THE MOTION CARRIED.

CLARK MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF THOMAS DOANE AS ROBINSON TOWNSHIP ASSESSOR, EFFECTIVE JUNE 6, 2008. KUYERS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED.

DISCUSSION WAS HELD ON THE NEED TO HAVE TEMPORARY HELP IN THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE UNTIL RÉSUMÉ'S CAN BE REVIEWED AND A FULL TIME ASSESSOR IS HIRED. MELISSA KOSTER AND JOE CLARK BOTH SAID THEY COULD FILL THE TEMPORARY POSITION. MELISSA KOSTER WAS AVAILABLE ON TUESDAYS AND REQUIRED A WAGE OF \$35.00 PER HOUR. JOE CLARK WAS AVAILABLE DURING THE DAY, EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS. HE REQUIRED A WAGE OF \$25.00 PER HOUR.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO EMPLOY JOE CLARK AS A TEMPORARY ASSESSOR AT HE RATE OF PAY OF \$25.00 PER HOUR UP TO 10 HOURS PER WEEK, UNTIL THE POSITION IS FILLED. KUYERS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN: AYES: STILLE-MULLIGAN, FRYE, KUYERS, BERENS. NAYS: NONE. ABSTAIN: CLARK. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

KUYERS MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION. THE MOTION CARRIED.
