

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

SUPERVISOR MULLIGAN OPENED THE MEETING. BERNICE BERENS GAVE AN INVOCATION THAT WAS FOLLOWED BY THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. HAYWARD SUPPORTED THE MOTION. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MAY MINUTES AND TO MAKE A CHANGE TO THE 01/19/09 MINUTES (ADDING THAT JOE CLARK WAS APPOINTED AS A REPRESENTATIVE TO NOCH.) THE MOTION WAS SECONDED BY FRYE. THE MOTION CARRIED.

SUPERVISOR MULLIGAN GAVE AN UPDATE ON THE GYPSY MOTH SPRAYING, THE GRAND RIVER TOUR, AND VANDALISM THAT WAS DONE TO THE TOWNSHIP PARK.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO REAPPOINT DIANE BOERS AS ROBINSON TOWNSHIP REPRESENTATIVE TO THE LOUIT DISTRICT LIBRARY. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE LOUIT LIBRARY TAX COLLECTION FEE OF \$1.50 PER PARCEL. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

FRYE MADE A MOTION TO REFUND \$300.00 IN FEES PAID BY VICKIE POTTER AS THE SITE PLAN REVIEW AND SPECIAL USE APPLICATION WAS NOT NEEDED. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: BERENS, MULLIGAN, HAYWARD, AND FRYE. NAYS: NONE. THE MOTION PASSED.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF A NEW COMPUTER AND SCANNER FOR THE DEPUTY TREASURER, NOT TO EXCEED \$1200.00. MULLIGAN SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: HAYWARD, BERENS, FRYE, AND MULLIGAN. THE MOTION CARRIED.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT 90-01 RE: STREET ID AND NAMING. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: FRYE, BERENS, MULLIGAN, AND HAYWARD. THE MOTION CARRIED.

BERENS MADE A MOTION TO DENY THE MACIEJEWSKI REZONING REQUEST. FRYE SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: MULLIGAN, HAYWARD, BERENS AND FRYE. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

DISCUSSIONS WERE HELD CONCERNING THE TOWNSHIP PARK, WATER ISSUES, TRI CITIES FOOTBALL, REINSTATING AN INFRASTRUCTURE ACCOUNT AND LEGAL MATTERS.

TREASURER HAYWARD GAVE A REPORT ON VARIOUS BANK INTEREST RATES. OTHER REPORTS ARE ON FILE.

MULLIGAN MADE A MOTION TO REDUCE OUR JANITORIAL SERVICE TO ONE DAY PER WEEK. FRYE SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO REDUCE THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR'S HOURS TO EIGHT PER WEEK. BERENS SUPPORTED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION WAS APPROVED.

MULLIGAN MADE A MOTION FOR ROBINSON TOWNSHIP TO SUPPORT NORP BECOMING AN AUTHORITY. HAYWARD SUPPORTED THE MOTION. A ROLL CALL VOTE WAS TAKEN. AYES: FRYE, HAYWARD AND MULLIGAN. NAYS: BERENS. THE MOTION CARRIED.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO PAY THE BILLS THAT WAS SUPPORTED BY BERENS. THE MOTION CARRIED.

HAYWARD MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. FRYE SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 9:55 P.M.
